## 40 HOURS OF TRAINING OVER 5 DAYS

This entire course is conducted online via Zoom and covers the same material as the residency version.

This course is designed for law enforcement personnel who are responsible for deploying in the capacity as a SWAT team leader or as a supervisor who is responsible for the training and deployment of tactical teams. The focus of this training will be on pre-incident training, planning, organizing, and the tactical decision-making process used in the resolution of high-risk operations. Attendees will participate in-group discussions, write operations orders, and develop training plans, plus critique and evaluate tactics and decisions based on a principle-based SWAT decision-making process.

*This version of SWAT Command Decision-Making and Leadership I is conducted entirely online through a live instructor-led process. Students will need computer or tablet with webcam and microphone capabilities in order to participate in this course.*
