WHY AGENCY RESPONSE TO CRITICAL INCIDENTS?

The Agency Response to Critical Incidents course is designed to educate police personnel on the essential steps required to effectively respond to a critical incident while supporting officer mental health and well-being.

1/3 of officers mentioned administrative stress as being worse than the operational stress experienced from the job.



Administrative stress can lead to burnout, anxiety, depression, and PTSD in officers.



Clear policies and better access to mental health services were cited as strategies to reduce administrative stress.
