### 24 HOURS OF TRAINING OVER 3 DAYS

This course is designed to address procedures and tactics relevant to resolving incidents involving subjects in crisis and armed barricaded criminal suspects. Upon successful completion, students will gain an understanding of the dynamics in such scenarios and learn how to implement tactics and principles for managing barricaded incidents. The curriculum covers force options and their appropriate use, the levels of force and subject resistance, as well as the roles and responsibilities of SWAT Team members during barricade situations. Additional topics include deployment criteria, legal considerations, technology deployment and less-lethal options. Intended for tactical operators, this course challenges participants to understand and apply both fundamental and advanced tactical concepts.

- Responding to Situations Where Suspects or Subjects Are Barricaded in a Structure or Vehicle
- Applying Different Methods to Resolve the Situation
- Understand the NTOA Critical Thinking Model and Safety Priorities
- Determine Appropriate Tactics Based on the Type of Barricade and Team Response Criteria
- Assess Force Options Based on Suspect/Subject Levels of Resistance
- Assess Legal Considerations Based on Suspect/Subject Levels of Resistance
- Create Awareness of Less Lethal and Technology Options During Response
- Create Awareness of the Priorities of Work in the First 30 Minutes of a Critical Incident
- Understand CNT Strategies and Tactics During Barricade Situations
- Create Awareness of Post-Operation Procedures after a Barricade Response
